



PLC OCA Bursary Policies and Procedures

The Bursary process is managed by the PLC Old Collegians' Association Inc. Committee.

For each Bursary, the OCA Committee will nominate a panel of selectors. They may be committee members or other Old Collegians

Any student who meets the criteria for a bursary listed on the Bursary Information form may apply.

Note that students are not eligible to apply if they are already recipients of a scholarship or bursary from the school, the Parents' Committee or the OCA (unless it is a music bursary).

It is the Committee's policy that students are eligible to apply for a bursary even if they have a relative or friend who is a committee member. It would be unfair to Committee members (and the relevant relative or friend) that, because they volunteer time to the Association, their relatives and friends are excluded from applying for a bursary. However, it is compulsory that, if a selector is a relative or friend of an applicant for the bursary for which they are a selector, that selector will immediately disqualify themselves from the panel and be replaced by another selector with no conflict of interest.
