

Frequently Asked Questions about PLC Scholarships

Where can I find more information about PLC Scholarships?

Our website plc.wa.edu.au contains information about all Scholarships and Bursaries available to both non-enrolled and enrolled students.

How do I register for a PLC Scholarship?

Go to the PLC website and complete the application form. Please ensure that you read through everything thoroughly and apply for the correct scholarship. Ensure you submit all requested documents, as incomplete applications will not be considered.

Do I have to sit an exam at PLC?

Due to COVID-19 we will not be holding Scholarship examinations this year.

When are the Music Auditions?

Auditions will be held on 30 and 31 July. Auditions online will be available to those invited applicants not able to travel to PLC Perth.

When do Music Scholarship Applications close?

Music scholarship applications close on Thursday 2 July, 2020.

When do Academic and General Excellence Scholarship applications close?

Applications close on Friday 17 July, 2020.

When will I find out if I have received a Scholarship?

Candidates invited to attend an interview will be contacted by PLC after Monday 27 July, 2020. Interviews will be held at PLC between Monday 3 August and Friday 7 August. Candidates unable to travel to Perth will be able to be interviewed via Web-Ex.

What is the remission if I am awarded a Scholarship?

Scholarships offer a partial remission off tuition, boarding and music. Specific details can be found in the Scholarship section of our website.

Do I have to pay the School Acceptance Fee if I receive a Scholarship?

Yes. All students are required to pay the Acceptance Fee prior to being confirmed at PLC. The current Acceptance Fee for Year 7 is \$5,200, with a 10% discount offered for Old Collegians and a 50% discount offered for siblings of current PLC students.
