Who can apply	PLC welcomes applications from girls who are Australian Citizens or Permanent Residents residing in Western Australia and are currently in Year 6 at PLC or another school.
Criteria	Successful applicants will demonstrate exceptional ability across a range of academic areas.
How to apply	<p>Complete the online Scholarship Application and email to scholarships@plc.wa.edu.au, along with the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- A brief handwritten summary from your daughter outlining her reasons for applying to PLC for a scholarship or if she is already at PLC, what she is looking forward to most in the Senior School.- Copies of relevant references, certificates or commendations.- Latest school report and Year 3 and 5 NAPLAN results.- Reference from your daughter's current school (not required for current PLC students).
Selection process	A panel of senior members of PLC's staff will read all applications. A short-list of candidates will be invited into the School for an interview; successful applicants will be offered a scholarship.
Interviews	Interviews will be conducted during the week 3 to 7 August. Candidates living more than 400 km from Perth or overseas may arrange to interview online if invited to the second round.
Award and acceptance	<p>Successful candidates will be notified in writing by 12 August, 2020. Unsuccessful candidates will be notified as soon as possible after the awards are finalised. Acceptance of the Scholarship should be made via email to the Principal no later than Friday 14 August, 2020.</p> <p>The award of a Year 7 Academic Scholarship has a minimum value of 25 per cent and a maximum value of 50 per cent and covers Year 7 to Year 12. The Scholarship award is subject to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• A conscientious approach to the academic programme by the applicant.• A positive contribution to the School community by the applicant.• A commitment by the applicant and the applicant's family to commit to PLC and the life of the School.

Costs not covered by the Scholarship include the remainder of the tuition fees, technology, uniform, musical instruments and tuition, excursions, tours and co-curricular activities.

Acceptance Fee

Candidates who are already attending PLC or are confirmed to attend PLC in a later year and have already paid the acceptance fee will not be required to pay any additional administrative fees. Other successful candidates will be required to pay the PLC Acceptance Fee of \$5,200, which is deposited with the School's Foundation, supporting the funding of infrastructure projects and Foundation Scholarships.
