

Scholarship Registration	Applications open on Monday 22 June, 2020 via the PLC website plc.wa.edu.au .
Closing Date	Applications close at 5.00 pm (AWST) on Thursday 2 July, 2020.
Documentation	Application and documents should be emailed to scholarships@plc.wa.edu.au .
Who can apply	PLC welcomes applications from girls who are Australian Citizens or Permanent Residents residing in Western Australia and are currently in Year 6 at PLC or another school.
Criteria	Music Scholarships are awarded based on musical excellence as well as the current needs within the PLC Music Department. Applicants are required to have reached AMEB Grade 4 or equivalent.
How to apply	Complete the online Scholarship Application. Provide the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Copies of relevant references, exam or eisteddfod reports.- A completed copy of the teacher reference form.
Selection process	Our Director of Music, along with senior members of our Music department, will assess all applications and, based on these applications, some applicants will be invited to audition. Applicants will be notified by phone call they are invited to audition.
Auditions	Auditions will be held on 30 and 31 July, 2020 at PLC Perth. Candidates who are unable to travel to Perth will be invited to audition virtually via Web-Ex.
Award and acceptance	Successful candidates will be notified in writing by 12 August, 2020. Unsuccessful candidates will be notified as soon as possible after the awards are finalised. Acceptance of the Scholarship should be made via email to the Director of Music no later than Friday 14 August, 2020. The award of a Year 7 Music Scholarship provides free instrument/vocal tuition and remission of a minimum value of 25 per cent to a maximum value of 50 per cent of the academic fees from Years 7 to 12. The Music lesson component includes 32 x 40-minute individual lessons and instrument hire, if required. The Scholarship award is subject to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• A conscientious approach to the academic programme by the applicant.• Be a member of a choir• Be a member of the instrumental ensemble(s) as appropriate.

- Select Music as a classroom subject in both Year 9 and 10 (when Music becomes an elective).
- Maintain a high level of effort in their chosen area of music study.
- Be fully supportive and contribute to the musical life at PLC.
- Complete formal music assessment (AMEB or PLC Internal Assessment Programme or other).

In addition to the above conditions, the award of a Year 10 Music Scholarship is also subject to selecting Music as a subject throughout Years 11 and 12.

Costs not covered by the Scholarship include the remainder of the tuition fees, technology, uniform, excursions, tours and co-curricular activities.

Acceptance Fee

Candidates who are already attending PLC or are confirmed to attend PLC in a later year and have already paid the acceptance fee will not be required to pay any additional administrative fees. Other successful candidates will be required to pay the PLC Acceptance Fee of \$5,200, which is deposited with the School's Foundation, supporting the funding of infrastructure projects and Foundation Scholarships.

Rural bursary
