

Music Bursaries

GENERAL INFORMATION

Music Instrumental/Vocal Bursaries are available to girls in Year 7 - 12 in 2021. Music Bursaries are awarded based on musical excellence as well as the current needs within the PLC Music Department.

The award of Music Bursaries is based on a Music audition/interview only.

Instrumental and Vocal Bursary applicants are required to meet the following minimum standard:

Year 6 in 2020 – AMEB Grade 2 or equivalent)
 Year 7 and 8 in 2020 – AMEB Grade 3 (or equivalent)
 Years 9 to 11 in 2020 – AMEB Grade 4 (or equivalent)

Based on the applications submitted some applicants will be invited to audition. Auditions will be held in the Music Department at PLC towards the end of Term 3.

All applicants will be notified by e-mail as to whether they are required to audition. For the audition applicants are required to perform with a piano accompanist where appropriate.

INSTRUMENTAL AND VOCAL BURSARY INFORMATION

Up to ten Instrumental and Vocal Bursaries are available in 2021. Each Bursary provides free instrument/vocal tuition and includes 32 x 40 minute individual lessons and instrument hire if necessary. The Bursary is available for 2021 but may be extended to include tuition fees and instrument hire in future years based on a satisfactory yearly review.

TERMS OF MUSIC BURSARIES

Music Bursary holders will be expected to:

- be a member of instrument/vocal ensemble(s) as appropriate
- normally take classroom music in Years 9 and 10
- maintain a high level of achievement in their chosen area of music study
- be fully supportive and contribute to the musical life at PLC
- complete formal music assessment (AMEB, PLC Internal Assessment Programme, etc)
