

## THE PLC FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

### Terms and Conditions

This document outlines the Terms and Condition for PLC Foundation Scholarships offered by the PLC Foundation. Parents and the scholarship recipient will be asked to sign this document on acceptance of a PLC Foundation Scholarship.

#### *Eligibility Requirements:*

- *Successful progress in academic goals*  
The student is required to give of her best to the academic programme through exemplary attendance, conscientious effort and acceptance of advice and additional support. The student's academic progress will be reviewed annually.
- *Attendance*  
All scholarships are awarded on the basis that the student will remain enrolled at PLC until the conclusion of Year 12.
- *Participation*  
The student is expected to engage in the life of the School by participating in a wide range of co-curricular activities. The student will be expected to participate in at least one co-curricular activity per Term; and to prioritise representing the School over Club commitments both sport and non-sport.

It is compulsory for the student to attend the PLC Foundation Annual General Meeting; attendance gives the student and the PLC Foundation members an opportunity to meet.

- *Tour and Exchanges*  
The PLC community have made generous donations to make this Scholarship possible. Out of respect to the student's benefactors, applications for international PLC Tours and Exchanges will be required to be approved by the PLC Foundation or benefactor, in the first instance, before being considered by the School.
- *Reflection*  
At the end of each year, the student will be asked to provide the Co-ordinator, PLC Foundation with her reflections on her academic and general progress. This is an opportunity to inform the School of any additional assistance *the student* may require to achieve her goals.
- *Family support*  
It is expected that the student's parents will support the aims of the School and the scholarship programme. Regular communication between the School, teachers and parents' needs to be maintained. Parents are encouraged to contact teachers and are always welcome to visit the School.
- *Financial information*  
Parents will be asked to provide confirmation of financial circumstances during the term of the Scholarship. If your financial circumstances change, please advise the Co-ordinator, PLC Foundation.
- *Additional charges*  
This Scholarship covers tuition fees only. The scholarship does not cover uniform, textbooks, Information and Learning technology fee, tours and exchanges. Boarding fees are not covered, unless specified.

The PLC Foundation reserves the right to withdraw the Scholarship if circumstances according to which the Scholarship is offered change substantially; or if the conditions of the scholarship are breached. These Terms and Conditions may be updated during the course of the student's enrolment.
