Enrolment for Lessons

Students continuing their instrumental or vocal studies do not need to re-enrol each year. Students will automatically be re-enrolled for the next year and parents' accounts charged for the first term's fees.

New Enrolments

New enrolments for Term 1 must be completed by **24 January 2022**. New applications may also be made during the year using this form, with lessons commencing at the beginning of term.

Lesson Types

Lessons can be individual or shared (with 1 other student).

Parents should seek advice from music staff to determine which is most suitable for their child. It is recommended that students who have moved beyond the beginner level should elect individual lessons.

Shared lessons can only be offered where a suitable partner is available. Otherwise, only an individual lesson can be offered.

All piano and drum kit lessons are offered on an individual basis only.

Commencement Age

The appropriate commencing age of students for instruments is based on a child's physical growth patterns and maturity.

The following is a guide to assist parents:

From Pre-Kindergarten

Piano, Violin, Cello (Suzuki method)

From Year 2

Viola (Suzuki method)

From Year 3

Voice (Singing), Violin,

Viola, Cello (traditional)

From Year 4

Double Bass, Guitar

From Year 5

Flute, Oboe, Clarinet, Bassoon, Trumpet (Cornet), French Horn, Trombone, Baritone, Tuba, Percussion (Drum Kit), Saxophone

From Year 6

Bagpipes

From Year 7

Euphonium, Pipe Drums, Bass Guitar

Suzuki Method of Instrumental Learning

PLC provides the opportunity for children to learn Violin, Viola, Cello and Piano using the Suzuki method of learning.

Named after the Japanese violinist and music teacher Dr Shinichi Suzuki, this teaching philosophy is based on the idea that children can learn to play music competently from a young age through motivation, modelling and repetition, just as they learn to talk fluently.

Parent involvement is integral to this method, therefore, parents are required to attend their child's lessons and supervise regular home practice. In addition, students will attend regular group classes (strings only) to reinforce what is taught in the lessons.

The Suzuki method of learning is highly recommended for children aged 3 - 8.

Tuition Fees for 2022

(based on 32 lessons per year)

Individual 30 min \$1,512 per annum*
Individual 40 min \$2,016 per annum*
Shared 30 min (2 per lesson) \$912 per annum*

Instrument Hire

A limited number of instruments owned by the School are available for hire. A separate hire application form will be required for each instrument and hirers will accept full responsibility for its care.

A single fee of \$325* per year applies to all hire instruments. No reduction in hire fee is possible where discontinuation of tuition occurs within the year. Please note we do not hire pianos, guitars or drums.

Payment of Fees

Fees are charged on an annual basis and payable in quarterly instalments along with School fees.

Following completion of 32 lessons, students will continue to receive lessons until the end of Term 4 at an additional charge.

Lesson Charges

A charged lesson occurs when the student has attended their scheduled lesson or was absent due to forgetfulness, illness or for family reasons (including holidays).

A non-charged lesson occurs when the student is unable to attend their lesson because of a School camp, excursion or exam where one week's notice is given.

Terms & Conditions of Tuition

- No student may commence, amend or withdraw from instrumental tuition without a written request from their parent/guardian.
- The Music Department must receive written notification at least two weeks prior to the end of term or the following term's fees will be charged.
