

Music Bursary Information 2024

GENERAL INFORMATION

Music Instrumental/Vocal Bursaries are available to girls in Year 7 - 12 in 2024. Music Bursaries are awarded based on musical excellence as well as the current needs within the PLC Music Department.

The award of Music Bursaries is based on a Music audition/interview only.

Instrumental and Vocal Bursary applicants are required to meet the following minimum standard:

- Year 6 in 2023 AMEB Grade 2 (or equivalent)
- Year 7 and 8 in 2023– AMEB Grade 3 (or equivalent)
- Years 9 to 11 in 2023 AMEB Grade 4 (or equivalent)

Based on the applications submitted some applicants will be invited to audition. Auditions will be held in the Music Department at PLC between Monday 11 September - Wednesday 13 September.

All applicants will be notified by e-mail as to whether they are required to audition. For the audition, applicants are required to perform with a piano accompanist where appropriate.

Copies of relevant references, exam or eisteddfod reports should be included with your application form. The teacher reference form should be completed and returned. Applications close on Monday 28 August 2023.

INSTRUMENTAL AND VOCAL BURSARY INFORMATION

Each Bursary provides free instrument/vocal tuition and includes 32 x 40 minute individual lessons and instrument hire if necessary. The Bursary is available for 2024 but may be extended to include tuition fees and instrument hire in future years based on a satisfactory yearly review.

TERMS OF MUSIC BURSARIES

Music Bursary holders will be expected to:

- be a member of instrument/vocal ensemble(s) as appropriate
- normally take classroom music in Years 9 and 10
- maintain a high level of achievement in their chosen area of music study
- be fully supportive and contribute to the musical life at PLC
- complete formal music assessment (AMEB, PLC Internal Assessment Programme, etc)
