The PLC Foundation Scholarship is awarded to students who would otherwise be unable to attend PLC due to their family's financial circumstances. The PLC Foundation Scholarship is offered to successful students commencing PLC in Year 7 and covers full tuition fees from Years 7 to 12.

Applicants are required to be a citizen or permanent resident of Australia, residing in Western Australia. Applicants must sit the PLC academic testing and provide evidence of a sound academic record, a commitment to community service and participation in co-curricular activities.

The family of eligible applicants must be able to verify that their family's financial situation would mean they would otherwise not be able to attend PLC. Shortlisted applicants will be required to have their financial position assessed by Edstart [edstart.com.au], an evaluator independent of PLC, at no cost to the family.
